US Senate (R): Congressman Mike Collins vs. Former Football Coach Derek Dooley

- Collins won with 55.54% of the vote and will face Jon Ossoff (D, incumbent) in the general election

Governor (R):Healthcare CEO Rick Jackson vs. Lieutenant Governor Burt Jones

- Jackson won with 52.65% of the vote and will face Former Atlanta Mayor Keisha Lance Bottoms (D) in the general election

Lieutenant Governor (R): State Sen. Greg Dolezal vs. Former State Sen. John F. Kennedy

- Dolezal won with 54.20% of the vote and will face State Sen. Josh McLaurin (D) in the general election

Lieutenant Governor (D): State Sen. Josh McLaurin vs. Former State Sen. Nabilah Parkes

- McLaurin won with 54.88% of the vote and will face State Sen. Greg Dolezal (R) in the general election

- Reynolds won with 63.10% of the vote and will face State Rep. Tim Fleming (R) in the general election

- Waites won with 58.70% of the vote and will face Commissioner John King (R, incumbent) in the general election

State School Superintendent (R): Dr. Fred “Bubba” Longgear vs. State School Superintendent Richard Woods (incumbent)

- Woods won with 51.19% of the vote and will face Dr. Lydia Powell (D) in the general election

Labor Commissioner (D): Nikki Porcher vs. Michelle Michi Sanchez

- Hollowell won with 52.95% of the vote and will face Businessman Jim Kingston (R) in the general election

US House District 7 (D): Tony Kozycki vs. Case Norton

- Kozycki won with 67.73% of the vote and will face Congressman Rich McCormick (R, incumbent) in the general election

US House District 11 (R): Rob Adkerson vs. John Cowan

- Seat currently held by Congressman Barry Loudermilk
- Cowan won with 64.98% of the vote and will face Chris Harden (D) in the general election

US House District 12 (D): Traci “Acree” George vs. Ceretta Smith

- Smith won with 55.79% of the vote and will face Congressman Rick Allen (R, incumbent) in the general election

- Seat currently held by State Sen. Josh McLaurin
- Abel won with 50.87% of the vote and will face Mike Dvorscak (R) in the general election

State Senate District 46 (R): Doug McKillip vs. Marc McMain

- Seat currently held by State Sen. Bill Cowsert
- McMain won with 64.53% of the vote and will face Ray Smith (D) in the general election

State Senate District 51 (R): Philip Milam vs. State Rep. Will Wade

- Seat currently held by State Sen. Steve Gooch

- Wade won with 61.20% of the vote and will face Gary St. Lawrence (D) in the general election

State House District 47 (R): Brian Cochran vs. Jack Miller

- Seat currently held by Speaker Pro Tempore Jan Jones
- Miller won with 62.98% of the vote and will face Lindsay Defranco (D) in the general election

State House District 58 (D): Demetria Henderson vs. Mathewos Samson

- Seat currently held by State Rep. Park Cannon
- Samson won with 66.25% of the vote and will face Torrey Balam (R) in the general election

State House District 62 (D): Kavon Arnold vs. Kenn Collier

- Seat currently held by State Rep. Tanya Miller
- Collier won with 62.15% of the vote and will run unopposed in the general election

State House District 68 (D): Mark Baker vs. Timoria McQueen Saba

- Seat currently held by State Rep. Derrick Jackson
- Saba won with 52.12% of the vote and will run unopposed in the general election

State House District 94 (D): Kelly Kautz vs. State Rep. Venola Mason (incumbent)

- Mason won with 77.25% of the vote and will run unopposed in the general election

State House District 117 (D): State Rep. Mary Ann Santos (incumbent) vs. Kim Thomas Smith

- Smith won with 87.82% of the vote and will run unopposed in the general election

State House District 177 (D): Elsie Cason Napier vs. Alvin Payton, Jr.

- Seat previously held by Former State Rep. Dexter Sharper
 - Napier won with 58.36% of the vote and will run unopposed in the general election
